

EMT LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

The information listed below is to assist you in providing the necessary documents along with your application & appropriate fee to renew your EMS license. It is NOT necessary to provide a criminal history release form when renewing your license, we already have one on file.

FEE OPTIONS:

- Standard two year renewal - \$10.00
Please send check or money order made out to ADPH Office of EMS and Trauma.
- One year renewal - \$5.00
Please send check or money order made out to ADPH Office of EMS and Trauma.

All active EMTs must have a form completed by their service's off-line Medical Director, or an on-line Medical Director or authorized designee attesting to their mastery of the skills and knowledge of the Alabama Treatment Protocols. As a part of completing the form, the physician or authorized designee will randomly select three protocol scenarios from a selection of scenarios provided by the State EMS Division. The EMT must satisfactorily verbally complete the selected scenarios based on the Alabama Treatment Protocols and the physician or authorized designee must attest to this by signing off on documentation including the EMT's name, license number, and physician's signature and/or authorized designee.

EMT LEVELS RE-LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

PARAMEDIC

- Application
- Forty-eight (48) hours of continuing education related to any EMS topic obtained during your license cycle.
- Full Protocol Certificate dated 2010 or 2011 for EMT Protocol Review with a skills and scenario verification certificate.
- Protocol Update Certificate dated 2011 for review of changes to full protocols.
- Declaration of U.S. Citizenship and Lawful Presence of an Alien form or the SAVE form with documents.
- Clear copy of an Alabama driver license or a birth certificate.
- An approved CPR course and an official typed CPR card.
- Photo (see the application for specifications)
- License Fee

INTERMEDIATE

- Application
- Thirty-six (36) hours of continuing education related to any EMS topic obtained during your license cycle.
- Full Protocol Certificate dated 2010 or 2011 for EMT Protocol Review with a skills and scenario verification certificate.
- Protocol Update Certificate dated 2011 for review of changes to full protocols.
- Declaration of U.S. Citizenship and Lawful Presence of an Alien form or the SAVE form with documents.
- Clear copy of an Alabama driver license or a birth certificate.
- An approved CPR course and an official typed CPR card.
- Photo (see the application for specifications)
- License Fee

EMT

- Application
- Twenty-four (24) hours of continuing education related to any EMS topic obtained during your license cycle.

- Full Protocol Certificate dated 2010 or 2011 for EMT Protocol Review (all 101 pages) with scope of practice.
- Protocol Update Certificate dated 2011 for review of changes to full protocols.
- Declaration of U.S. Citizenship and Lawful Presence of an Alien form or the SAVE form with documents.
- Clear copy of an Alabama driver license or a birth certificate.
- An approved CPR course and an official typed CPR card
- Photo (see the application for specifications)
- License Fee

EMT

You must be a Nationally Registered EMT to apply for the first issuance of an Alabama EMT license. The license fee is \$10.00 for two years. Applications can be mailed or faxed to you upon request.

Paramedic

You must be a Nationally Registered Paramedic to apply for the first issuance of an Alabama Paramedic license. The license fee is \$10.00 for two years. Applications can be mailed or faxed to you upon request.
